Study program: Janjos College study program is a full-time three or four-year program in **management or business informatics**. Each academic year is divided into two semesters. All core courses are taken during the first and second year. During the third and fourth year students take all their electives and concentrations. It is possible to focus on the following areas divided in five licensed study programs: **Entrepreneurship, Banking and Finance, Public Administration, Trade and Marketing, Business Informatics**. In addition to all the elective work, students must carry out their internship or practical assignment in their area of concentration.

The college proposes educational programs in economical and business areas, integrated with business information technologies, adjusted to the present and future needs of the economical development of Bosnia and Herzegovina, taking into consideration the necessity of training senior managers and business IT specialists.

Program goals:

The idea of creating the college stems from the following motives: provide present and future agents of economic and business world with extensive knowledge in these areas; formalize high educational, scientific and research activities in order to boost the country's economical development; promote employment and self-employment through the creation of small and medium-sized businesses; encourage entrepreneurial spirit; train national managers for international business and integration into the international business. **The Bachelor of Science in Management** prepares academically qualified students to enter, compete, and be successful in the global industries or domestic enterprise. The student interacts with and learns from professionals in the business community. Whether entering the corporate world or undertaking an entrepreneurial

venture, the graduate is equipped with the necessary business analytical, planning, and management tools; ethical understanding; and leadership skills to be successful.

Domestic businesses depend heavily on information and manipulating that information to be competitive in a global economy — that means a strong and continuing need for information systems specialists and especially knowledge workers to fill positions such as:

- business process analyst
- project manager
- information systems designer
- database & data security specialists

A **Bachelor of Science degree in Business Informatics** from Janjos College gives technical, analytical, business, and systems know-how to integrate computer technology into vital business operations and administrative tasks — whether it's for a private or non-profit organization, a government agency, or an educational institution.

Full-time workload:	Students must take minimum of 60 credit hours per semester.
Courses:	A complete course offering is available at the website.
Language of instruction:	All courses are taught in Bosnian/Croatian/Serbian language.
Language courses:	English (on campus)
Language requirement:	There is no specific minimum language proficiency requirement in Bosnian/Croatian/Serbian; however, students must be able to actively participate in class discussions.
Methodology:	50% case study analysis and discussion and 50% lecture. The specific method depends on the nature of the course.
Grading system:	Janjos College uses the traditional university grading system inherited from former Yugoslavia. Numerical grades are used as follows: 10 Outstanding 9 Excellent 8 Very good 7 Good 6 Satisfactory 5 Unsatisfactory (failing)
